FALL LEAF PICK-UP

Curbside pick-up for homes with Monday garbage collection will be **Saturday, November 18th**. Grass, leaves, and small sticks in **CLEAR** plastic bags will be accepted, as well as **SMALL** bundles of sticks.

Drop-off from 8:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m., **Saturday, November 11th** near the Town Hall in Zenda. Grass, leaves, and small sticks in **CLEAR** plastic bags will be accepted, as well as **SMALL** bundles of sticks.

The Town allows burning of manageable amounts of yard debris if weather conditions are favorable and as long as the fire is attended, not allowed to smolder, and is not a danger or nuisance to neighbors.

PRESCRIPTION AND OVER THE COUNTER DRUG DISPOSAL

Old and unwanted prescription and over-the-counter drugs can be placed in the collection box for unwanted drugs in the foyer at the Town of Linn offices complex in Zenda.

GARBAGE COLLECTION

Normal bulky pick up is the second collection of the month. **DO NOT** leave TV's or other electronics for pick up. Note upcoming electronics recycling event listed below.

Garbage and recycling pick-up will also be delayed by one day the week of December 25th Christmas.

COMPUTER & ELECTRONICS RECYCLING DAY

Computer and electronics should be brought to the Highway Garage in Zenda for recycling **SUNDAY, October 8th** from 9:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. Items accepted at no charge are: computers, laptops, hard drives, printers, scanners, VCR's, DVD's, FAX, stereo, radio, typewriters, keyboards, mice, circuit boards, cables, cell phones, telephones, digital cameras, and camcorders.

There is a \$20.⁰⁰ charge for each TV, any size or type, payable in **CASH** only.

CLEAN SWEEP

The **City of Delavan** will host **Clean Sweep Friday, October 6, from 3:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m.** The drop-off location is the Delavan Public Works garage at 490 Richmond Road (County Roads M & P, just north of Wisconsin School for the Deaf).

Walworth County Highway Department, W4097 County Road NN, just west of Aurora Lakeland Hospital, will accept Clean Sweep items **Saturday, October 7th** from 8:00 a.m. until Noon.

Hazardous waste (products labeled caustic, acid, flammable, danger, warning, or poison) will be accepted as well as vehicle and household batteries, fluorescent bulbs and items containing mercury. There is **NO CHARGE** for household Clean Sweep.

Latex paint **WILL NOT** be accepted as it can be dried and disposed of in the regular, weekly garbage collection.

Items **NOT** accepted are: prescription and over-the-counter drugs, radioactive items, sharps/needles, oxygen tanks & nebulizers. Contact Stephanie Rodgers at Walworth County Solid Waste for collection programs for these materials.
